Iraq War Resolution on ballot; forum planned

Madison residents will have the opportunity to vote on the following resolution on April 4:

“Resolved: The United States should bring all military personnel home from Iraq now.”

The Bring Our Troops Home (BOTH) Coalition will host a public forum on the resolution Tuesday, March 28, 7 p.m. at the Warner Park Community Center.

A major goal for the BOTH Coalition is for the resolution to spark a wider discussion among voters about the war and occupation. Public forums and debates offer wonderful opportunities for such discussions. Several debates are in the planning stages now. The group is convinced that a successful outpouring of “yes” votes April 4 will send a powerful message to Washington that most Madisonians expect a withdrawal of troops as soon as possible, beginning now.

Everybody’s opinion is important. BOTH encourages everyone to come to the forum to share comments and views about the war and resolution.
